

1 Kings 9:10–10:29

Introduction: Two sides of the same coin

1. Bless God for the wise and prosperous King.

Implication:

- *“Something greater than Solomon is here.”*
(Cf. Matt 12:38–42, Col 2:3, Eph 3:3–14)

2. Bless God for the obedient and generous King.

Implications:

- *“though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor”*
(Cf. 2 Cor 8:9, Phil 2:8)
- *“Seek God's Kingdom”*
(Cf. Luke 12:22–34)

Conclusion: 1 Kings 10:9

“Blessed be the LORD our God, who has delighted in Jesus and set Him on the throne of Israel! Because the LORD loved His people forever, He has made Jesus king, that He may execute justice and righteousness.”
